LOCAL LARPS

The participants from each country must organize 1 LARP event in their country within 4 months after the Training.

We will assist and support you online with this task.



CONTINUATION

This training is part of The Larp Alchemy Training series, which continued twice per year with a new agenda each time, the Participants are welcome to come regularly and co-create the Programs of the next ones.

WVENUE

- Villa ReZone a comfortable guest house adapted to the needs of international trainings with all-included modern facilities, home to several larp, board game and theater projects insofar
- Rabka-Zdrój a small town in Polish mountains, clean air, classic villas, vast public parks and health resort facilities, 65 km from the city of Kraków,

ACCOMMODATION

All Participants will be accommodated in Villa Rezone in Rabka-Zdrój. Towels, bedsheets will be provided for you. Showers or bathtubs are available in the rooms. You can buy your own cosmetics in a local shop nearby.

SFOOD

You will receive 3 meals per day, according to the diet specified in the Sign Up Form. Check the time of the meals in the Program. No food will be served after specified hours. If you want to eat at different hours, you may easily find various options in the town, within a 15-minute walk, but then you need to pay for yourself.

Hot drinks and cookies will be provided in the Venue during Coffee Breaks.





INSURANCE

Accident and liability insurance will be provided for the whole group. The insurance doesn't cover the medical treatment, therefore every participant is obliged to bring their European Insurance Card. The organizers will help you with reaching medical facilities, but will not cover the costs of medical treatment.





TRAVEL COSTS

The participants should book their travel and pay for it by themselves, they will receive the reimbursement of travel costs later after the Training.

The maximum cost of the reimbursement is specified according to the Erasmus+ Program Guide for the year 2022.

If you plan to travel by car, please contact the organizers in advance.

The limits should be enough to travel to Poland and back, please plan your travel carefully, choose economic options. If you spend less on your travel you will get exactly the amount you spent. If you spend more, you will get the amount from the table.

Please keep all tickets/bills/invoices from your travel. It will be needed to proceed with the reimbursement. You will need to fill out a Reimbursement Form within 2 weeks







after the Training and you will receive the Reimbursement within 1 month after sending us the Form.

If a Participant attends less than 80% of the Program or breaks the agreement in any way, they may be rejected to receive the reimbursement of the travel costs.

If you want to receive the Travel Reimbursement, the date of your Travel must be not sooner than 2 days before the Arrival Day and no later than 2 days after the Departure Day specified in the Program.

If you decide to come to Poland a few days earlier or depart a few days later, you do it at your own expense and responsibility. It is not possible to extend the accommodation in the Venue, but it should be easy to find something by yourself in Rabka-Zdrój or in Kraków.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

If you arrive by airplane or long-distance bus or train, you will probably arrive in the city of Kraków, which is around 65 kilometers from Rabka-Zdrój.

Go to Central Bus Station in Kraków and get a bus directly to Rabka-Zdrój.

You can buy the ticket there at the box office, but better to check the timetable or book the ticket online: check the <u>Flixbus</u> or the <u>local buses</u>.

If you are coming by your own vehicle, come directly to Rabka, you will get a free parking spot in the Venue.

In Rabka, you can either walk 15 minutes to the Venue or take a taxi at your own expense, preferably from the Bolt or Uber app.
